## Lawn Tractor Classes, Rules, & Regulations

- Pulls begin at 3:00 PM
- Lawn Tractor Sign up from 1:00 until 2:45 PM.
- A drivers meeting will be held at 2:45 for Lawn Tractor Pullers.
- \$5.00 hitch fee per hook and a limit of 2 hooks.
- Admission: \$10 Adults - \$5 Children 12 & Under – Under 6 Free
- Trophies will be awarded for first place only.
- A pedal tractor race, for kids 6 & under, will be held as soon as the antique tractors have finished pulling. Pedal tractors will not be provided.
- All rules and regulations will be strictly adhered to and any decisions made by the rules committee will be final.

## Lawn Tractor Classes and Order of Pull

1. 700 lb. – 8 HP and Under – Stock – Turf Tires
2. 800 lb. – 8 HP and Under – Stock – Turf Tires
3. 900 lb. – 10 HP and above – Stock – Turf Tires
4. 900 lb. – 10 HP and above – Modified – Turf Tires
5. 900 lb. – 10 HP and above – Stock – Bar Tires
6. 900 lb. – 10 HP and above – Modified – Bar Tires
7. 1000 lb. – 10 HP and above – Stock – Turf Tires
8. 1000 lb. – 10 HP and above – Modified – Turf Tires
9. 1000 lb. – 10 HP and above – Stock – Bar Tires
10. 1000 lb. – 10 HP and above – Modified – Bar Tires

## **Wilkes County Young Farmer Truck & Tractor Pull**

### **2009 Lawn Tractor Rules & Regulations**

1. Drivers must exhibit the ability to control the tractor at all times. This is to include during weighing, technical inspections, before pull, backing up to sled and after pulling.
2. Drivers must stay on the seat of the tractor at all times. Hands must be on the steering wheel, hand brakes, hand clutch or throttle at all times during the pull.
- 3 No alcohol allowed. Obscene language will not be tolerated.
4. Anyone 12 years or under cannot participate in the modified classes. They must be able to prove their ability to handle the lawnmower to an official before being allowed to compete in any classes and be accompanied by a supervising adult.
5. Anyone 8 years of age or younger must have a parent/responsible adult or track official walk along side as they pull.
6. Track and safety officials have the authority to enforce all rules as stated herein and to disqualify any tractor for violations or unsafe conditions. All decisions are final.
7. Any questionable modifications or alterations will be reviewed by the rules committee to establish eligibility.
8. All rules will be interpreted by the rules committee. Any unforeseen problems or oversights will be ruled on by the rules committee with their rulings being final.
9. Lawn/garden tractors may pull only once in each class and are limited to two classes.
10. Wheelie bars are required.
11. All tractors should be of the Lawn/Garden tractor variety with a maximum of two cylinders.
12. Gas, diesel, or LPG fuels only. No alcohol. No nitrous oxide.
13. No "cut" tires allowed in stock classes. No radial tires, duels, chains, or studs allowed.
14. Each lawn/garden tractor must have operating brakes.
15. Front and rear wheel weights must be mounted to the wheels. Other weights shall not extend more than 16 inches from front of lawnmower frame and front and side frame weights must be mounted and secured. Suitcase weights are allowed.
16. Tractor draw bar point of hook (clevis) must be no higher than the centerline of the rear axle to the ground.
17. Stock tractors must have a muffler and cannot turn over 3600 RPM's.
18. The tractor must remain within the defined "in bounds" track area during the pull.
19. No "full throttle" starts or jerking sled. First offense - restart, Second offense -disqualification.
20. All tractors must have a seat, fenders, hood, grille or nosepiece, guards on belts, pulleys and starters, unless they did not have them from the factory. (This applies to stock classes only!!!!!!!)
